Matt Reid, General Manager of City and Community Services, Hutt City Council, will speak regarding the Fraser Park Sports & Community Hub project. Hutt City Council has embarked on a city wide rejuvenation project with unparalleled investment into new public infrastructure. The aim is for economic growth and for our communities to prosper. Fraser Park is the largest sporting hub in the region and a long term strategic asset for the Hutt Valley.

Prue Lamason

Prue Lamason is a Greater Wellington Regional Councillor, one of three councillors representing Lower Hutt. 'RiverLink' is a collaborative project between GWRC – CBD/Melling to Ewan flood works, Hutt City Council and New Zealand Transport Authority – redesign of Melling interchange with a new bridge and moving Melling Station. The RiverLink project will deliver better flood protection, better lifestyle and improved transport links for the people of central Lower Hutt.

Paul Swain

Paul Swain is a Greater Wellington Regional Councillor, representing Upper Hutt. 'Let's Get Wellington Moving' is working with Wellington to develop a transport system that supports your aspirations for how the city looks, feels, and functions. There are four scenarios put forward by NZTA, Wellington City Council and Greater Wellington Regional Council. Feedback will be reported by March 2018.
